For this week's Top 50 Microcap Investor we present Joe Koster, Managing Member and Portfolio Manager of Sorfis Investments, LLC. "Before launching Sorfis Investments in January 2019, Joe served as one of the Managing Members and Co-Portfolio Managers of Boyles Asset Management, LLC from April 2013 until December 2018. He worked for Chanticleer Holdings, Inc. (CHI) as an analyst from June 2005 until April 2013 and served as Co-Portfolio Manager for Chanticleer Advisors, a wholly-owned subsidiary of CHI. He earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration with a concentration in Finance from Coastal Carolina University. Joe is also the editor of the of the Value Investing World Newsletter. Additionally, Joe ran a microcap value fund called Chanticleer Investors II, LLC which launched on January 1, 2007 and closed on March 31, 2013. On July 25, 2013, Boyles Asset Management published a quarterly letter which included Joe's "Final Chanticleer Investor II Scorecard." The fund's cumulative return from inception to close net of fees was 136.74%, versus the Russell 2000's 35.78% and the S&P 500's 30.41%.
