For this week's Top 50 Microcap Investor we present Yaron Naymark, founder and portfolio manager of <u>1 Main Capital</u>. "Prior to founding 1 Main Capital, Yaron accumulated more than a decade of investing experience at multi-billion-dollar value-oriented public and private equity firms. Yaron is a South Florida native, a lover of the outdoors, and currently lives in New York City with his wife, son and dog." Naymark's boutique investment firm "makes concentrated investments in high-quality reasonably valued businesses with long reinvestment runways and in special situations that are experiencing a temporary dislocation or undergoing an element of change that will cause investors to revalue an investment in the near term."

According to 1 Main Capital's most recent <u>quarterly letter</u>, the fund "returned 9.7% net of fees and expenses, bringing the year-to-date return to 53.9%. Through the first nine months of the year, the S&P 500 (SPX) and Russell 2000 (RTY) Indexes returned 15.9% and 12.4%, respectively."
